Making Connections

Lesson Plan for *Superstars of the Stanley Cup Finals*
Grade 1

Objective

To help students make connections between ideas in a text to answer questions about a picture.

Things Needed

- *Superstars of the Stanley Cup Finals* book
- QR code scanner or access to the “Superstars of the Stanley Cup Finals” web page on the Pop! website: <http://popbooksonline.com/sports-greatest-superstars/superstars-of-the-stanley-cup-finals/>

Before the Activity

Read *Superstars of the Stanley Cup Finals* out loud to students.

Activity

Open *Superstars of the Stanley Cup Finals* to pages 14 and 15. Choose a student to read the text on page 14 out loud to the class. To learn more about the Stanley Cup, scan the QR code on page 15 or click on the “Learn More” tab of the “Superstars of the Stanley Cup Finals” web page. Choose a second student to read the text on this page out loud. Then have students look at the image on this page and answer the following questions, giving the students prompts and support as needed:

- What team has won the Stanley Cup in this picture? (Answer: the Los Angeles Kings)
- What clues from the book help you know this? (Answer: The player’s uniform in the picture matches the uniform in the picture on page 15.)
- What person do you think this picture shows? (Answer: It’s probably Jonathan Quick.)



- What clues from the book help you know this? (Answer: That's who Chapter 3, which this picture goes with, is about.)
- Another person was shown holding the Stanley Cup in the *Superstars of the Stanley Cup Finals* book. Who was it? (Answer: Sidney Crosby, shown on page 5)

Evaluation

Could students answer the questions about the text? Could they recall the similar image from an earlier chapter?

Standards

This lesson plan may be used to address the Common Core State Standards' reading standards for informational texts, grade 1 (RI 1.3, 1.6).
