


## Seasonal Item or Regular Item?

Imagine you are opening a new store. You have a lot of items, but not enough space to sell them all at the same time. One way to solve this would be to sell certain items by season. A season is a certain period of time where supply and demand changes. Halloween candy and summer clothes are examples of seasonal items. Using the circles below, sort the items you can sell by season and others you can sell all year round.
