MATERIALS:

Sunshine Bucket of Water Paintbrush Notebook Pencil Driveway or Sidewalk

- Draw an idea for your water painting in a notebook with a pencil.
- 2 Fill the bucket with water, grab a paintbrush, and go outside.
- 3 Find two different spots on your driveway or sidewalk: one in the sun and one in the shade.
- Paint your picture with water in the sunny spot.

Paint your picture with water in the spot in the shode.

When you're done painting the second painting, go and look at the painting that was in the sun. Has it changed? How so? As more time passes, does the painting in the shade change? Draw any changes to your water painting next to your original idea in the notebook and talk about the difference with a friend or parent!
