Parts of a Predator

Lesson Plan for *Velociraptor* Grade 1

Objective

To help students use images and text to understand the body parts that help predators such as Velociraptor hunt.

Things Needed

- Velociraptor book
- Access to the "Velociraptor" web page on the Pop! website: http://popbooksonline.com/dinosaurs/velociraptor
- Access to the "DK Findout!: Velociraptor" website listed on the "Explore Links" tab

Before the Activity

Read *Velociraptor* out loud to students. Open the "Velociraptor" web page in your internet browser. Pull up the "Explore Links" tab and click the "DK Findout!: Velociraptor" link to open the website.

Activity

Reread Chapter 2 ("Deadly Claws"). Then, open the book to the image on page 13. This image labels some of Velociraptor's body parts. Ask students the following questions:

- Which of these body parts helped Velociraptor hunt? (Answer: all of them)
- How did these body parts help it hunt? (Possible Answers: The sharp teeth helped it bite its prey; the long and short claws helped it slash and grab its prey; the strong tail helped it balance while it attacked with its claws; etc.)



Next, read the caption on the left side of the "DK Findout!: Velociraptor" web page. Then use the following prompts to review each label on the image to the right:

- Do you think this body part helped Velociraptor hunt?
- Why or why not?

Evaluation

Could students answer the questions about Velociraptor's body parts? Check students' answers by clicking on the label and reading the text that appears.

Standards
