
## THE 100TH DAY OF SCHOOL

## **MATERIALS:**

10 pieces of colored paper glue or tape scissors

ruler pencil

- Pick out 10 sheets of colored paper. They can be the same color or different colors! Based on the example above, use the ruler and pencil to draw nine lines across one piece of paper.
- 2 Ask an adult to help you cut along the lines. You should now have 10 slips of paper.
- Repeat steps 2 and 3 for each piece of paper.

If you are using glue, put a small dab of glue on one edge of a paper slip. Place the other edge on top of it to create a ring. Hold the two ends together until the glue dries. If you are using tape, tape the ends together.

Place another strip of paper through the ring you made. Repeat step 4 to create a second ring that is linked with the first.

Repeat step 5 until all 100 rings are connected!
