

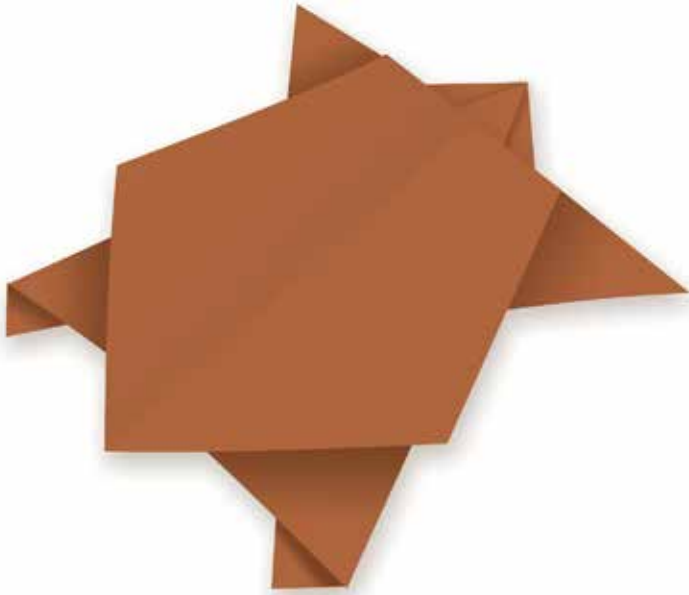
SEA TURTLES

Origami Craft

Make a paper turtle of your very own!


MATERIALS:


8 1/2 X 11-INCH SHEET OF
COLORED PAPER
SCISSORS








- 


Fold one corner of a piece of paper over to the opposite corner.
- 


Finish making the square by cutting off the small rectangle.
- 


Fold side to side and unfold. This is the "valley fold" or "river."
- 


Turn over and fold right and left points down to form a "roof."
- 


Then turn over the piece of paper.
- 


Bring the folded edges to meet the valley fold (the river). Crease flat.
- 


Unfold the top side points.
- 


The paper should look like this.
- 

Fold the top points down as shown.
- 

Fold the point upward to create a head.
- 

Lift the bottom edge to meet the vertical center line.
- 

Like this. Press flat and fold outward as shown.
- 

Repeat steps 11 and 12 with the other foot.
- 

Turn the paper over. You've made a turtle!
