Fancy First Aid Words

Lesson Plan for *First Aid Safety*
Grade 1

Objective

To help students build vocabulary for talking about first aid.

Things Needed

- *First Aid Safety* book
- Fancy First Aid Words worksheet (attached)
- Pens or pencils

Before the Activity

Print one copy of the Fancy First Aid Words worksheet for each student. Hand out the worksheets and make sure each student has a pen or pencil.

Activity

Instruct students to carefully read the *First Aid Safety* book on their own. They should fill in the blanks on the worksheet as they read. Each sentence on the worksheet gives the definition for a word related to first aid. Students should write this vocabulary word in the blank.

After all students complete their worksheets, go over the answers together as a class. Invite a different volunteer to answer each question. Use the attached answer key to check their answers. Have each student correct his or her worksheet as you go. Students should put a star by each correct answer and cross out any incorrect answers.

Evaluation

Collect the worksheets at the end of the activity. Did students answer and score the questions correctly?
