Playing Safely

Lesson Plan for *Playground Safety* Grade 1

Objective

To help students remember key ideas from a text about playing safely at a playground.

Things Needed

- Playground Safety book
- Access to the "Playground Safety" web page on the Pop! website: https://popbooksonline.com/safety-for-kids/playground-safety

Before the Activity

Open the "Playground Safety" web page in your internet browser. Pull up the "Explore Links" tab and click on the Safety 4 Kids article, "When Playing Outside." This article can also be found here:

Activity

Read *Playground Safety* out loud to students. Then read the "When Playing Outside" article. After you finish reading both the book and web page, have a class discussion about playground safety. Read each of the following questions and call on students for answers:

- What equipment is on the school playground? (Answers: climbing areas [p. 4], monkey bars [p. 5], swings [pp. 8–9, 14–15], slides [pp. 8–9, 14], seesaw [p. 13], merry-go-round [pp. 14–15])
- What are ways you can be safe while playing on those items? (Answers: Look before jumping down so you don't hurt yourself or others [p. 4]; touch equipment before using to make sure it's not too hot [p. 9]; don't run or play on slippery equipment [p. 9]; slide sitting down and feet first [pp. 13–15]; hold the seesaw when moving and don't climb in the middle [pp. 13–15]; hold onto bars on a merry-goround and don't crowd too many people on [pp. 13–15]; swing sitting and hold the chains [pp. 13–15].)



- According to the website, what is stranger danger? (Answer: when someone you don't know comes near and makes you feel unsafe)
- What should you do if you are playing and a stranger comes near? (Answers: Call out to adults nearby; don't talk to the person; walk away if you feel scared; kick and scream if needed.)

Evaluation

Could students use information from the book and website to think of ways to play safely?
