Reading About Ramadan

Lesson Plan for *Ramadan*

Grade 2

Objective

To help students use context clues to match vocabulary words with their definitions.

Things Needed

- *Ramadan* book
- Reading About Ramadan worksheet (attached)

Before the Activity

Print a copy of the Reading About Ramadan worksheet for each student.

Activity

Read the *Ramadan* book out loud to students. After finishing the book, pass out the Reading About Ramadan worksheet. Explain that this worksheet has key words from the book. Students should write the letter of each word next to the definition that matches it. Some of the words can be found in the book's glossary. For others, students will have to use the book's text and images for clues.

Evaluation

Give students 1 point for each correct match, for up to 10 points total.
