Lesson Plan for *Lumpia*

Grade 3

#### Objective

To help students recall key details from a text and practice finding information in sidebars, photo captions, and other text features.

#### Things Needed

- *Lumpia* book
- Learning About Lumpia worksheet (attached)

#### Before the Activity

Print a copy of the Learning About Lumpia worksheet for each student. Then read the *Lumpia* book out loud as a class.

#### Activity

Pass out the Learning About Lumpia worksheet. Students should use the word bank to fill in the blank in each sentence. They can look through the *Lumpia* book if they get stuck. Some of the answers will be described in the main text. Others will appear in photo captions and sidebars.

#### Evaluation

Use the attached answer key to give students 1 point for each correct answer, for up to 10 points total.
