Meerkat Mix-Up

Lesson Plan for *Meerkats*Grade 1

Objective

To help students practice recalling key details from texts about meerkats.

Things Needed

- Meerkats book
- Access to the "Meerkats" web page on the Pop! website: https://popbooksonline.com/desert-animals/meerkats
- Meerkat Mix-Up worksheet (attached)

Before the Activity

Read the Meerkats book out loud to students. Print out a worksheet for each student, or email the worksheet to students.

Activity

Open the "Meerkats" web page in your internet browser. Click on the "Learn More" tab. Read the caption for the image out loud to students. Then ask the following questions:

- What does this caption tell us about? (Answer: It describes meerkat burrows.)
- What are the burrows like? (Sample Answers: They go deep underground. Each burrow has many tunnels. It has multiple entrances and exits.)

To learn more about how burrows help meerkats, students will fill out the Meerkat Mix-Up worksheet. Explain that this worksheet has sentences about meerkat burrows. But one word in each sentence is all mixed up. Students should unscramble the letters and write this word in the space under the sentence. If they get stuck, they can look back through the *Meerkats* book.



Evaluation

After students have written their answers, use the attached answer key to reveal the correct answers and have students correct their work. If needed, you can use the page numbers provided in the answer key to give students clues during the activity as well.

Standards

This lesson plan may be used to address the Common Core State Standards' reading standards for informational texts, grade 1 (RI 1.2, 1.3).
