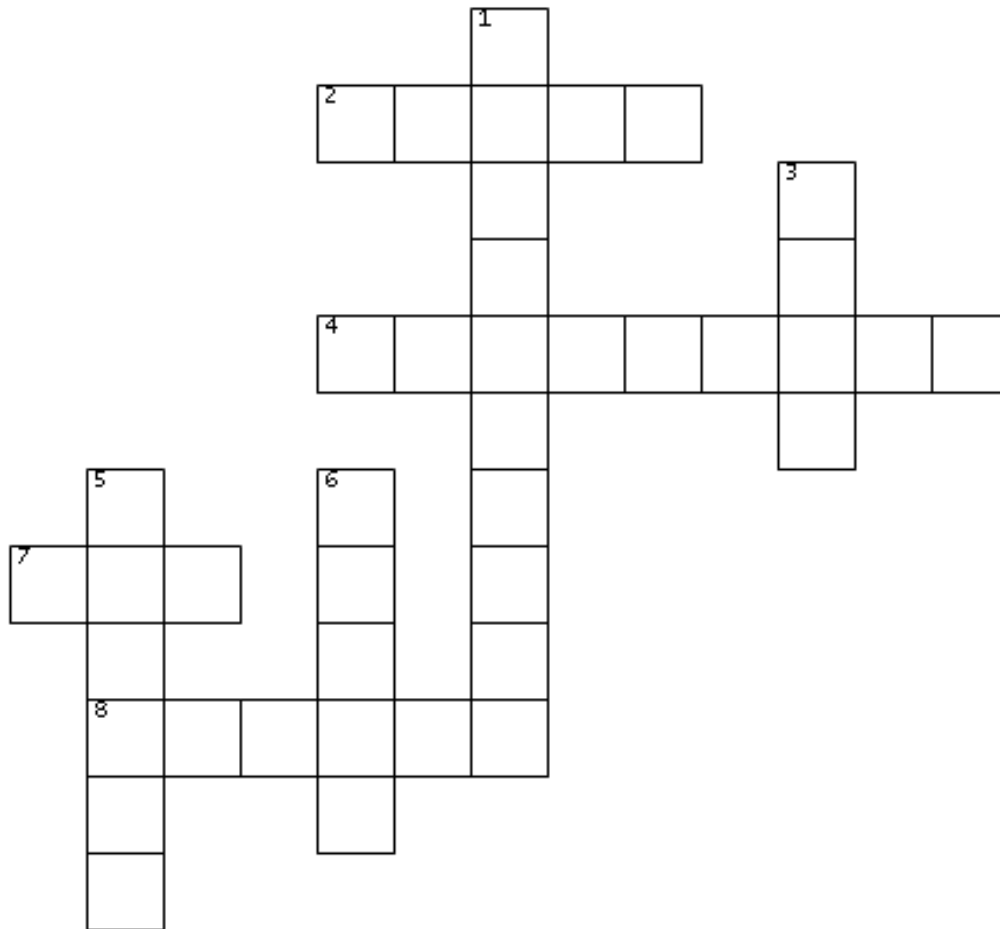


Lessons with Aesop's Fables
